Contribution Guide

The Antique Motorcycle Foundation, Inc. (Foundation) is a Florida corporation not-for-profit recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt charitable organization. Its purpose is to support programs and events that educate the public about antique motorcycles, the history of the industry and the sport of antique motorcycling. It provides support in the form of funding and member assistance to other non-profit organizations that share the Foundation's commitment to antique motorcycling. The Foundation is closely related to The Antique Motorcycle Club of America, Inc., but is a completely separate organization in its own right.

The Foundation may accept gifts and donations in the form of cash, checks, appreciated securities or gifts-in-kind. Gifts-in-kind are non-cash assets, such as motorcycles, or intellectual property such as motorcycle related documents or artifact, and/or literature. Gifts-in-kind require fair market appraisal to establish their value for tax deductibility which is the sole responsibility of the donor. Gifts and donations can be made of behalf of and/or in the honor of others.

Donors must make their contributions directly to The Antique Motorcycle Foundation, Inc. All donations and contributions must be made without stipulations or conditions, and will become the exclusive property of the Foundation. Each accepted gift will be formally recognized by the Foundation, and will receive the appropriate documentation for tax filing. Any Foundation Board member will direct you to the appropriate representative of the Foundation, and can provide the appropriate forms for beginning the gifting process.
